Applying Target To HWRS Screen



Introduction

The following information is provided to help in aligning camera with the image. The target adheres best in warm temperatures (70° F) .

Description

- 1. Start the Water Restraint System (WRS).
- 2. Align camera with the image as close to the center of the screen as possible.
- 3. Fire the system.
- 4. With an erasable ink marker, place a mark in the center of the firing area on the screen.
- 5. Remove the clear paper covering from the target.
- 6. Center the target, paper side up, over the mark on the screen. Align the target with notches at top, bottom, left and right as shown below:



- 7. With a hard object such as the bottom end of a pen or pencil, burnish all parts of the target. Press firmly but not hard enough to move the target or tear the paper.
- 8. Carefully, ROLL the paper back from one edge, over the target and off. Be very careful not to lift or stretch the vinyl target.
